- 1. How do I change the volume on my speaker?
 - a. Make sure the volume on your device is turned to maximum.
 - b. Your speaker comes with a multifunction toggle button (See page 7 for diagrams).
 - c. If you HOLD the multifunction button to the right/left, the volume on your speaker will increase/decrease respectively.
 - d. If you FLICK the multifunction button to right/left, you will skip to the next/previous song respectively.
 - e. If you PRESS the multifunction button when you receive a call, you can activate the hands free function to answer your call. PRESS it again when you are done to hang up the call.
- My speaker didn't work right out of the box:
 - a. Try charging the speaker first to ensure it has a full battery. While we make every effort to charge every battery before shipping the product to you, sometimes batteries lose charge during Quality Assurance Testing.










Connect the standard USB (3) to your computer or USB charger. While the battery is charging, the LED light will glow RED. Once charged, the LED light will turn BLUE. A single charge can last up to 8 hours.

Wired connection:


- You can connect your speaker to any device using the USB cable and the 3.5mm jack:
- 1. Slide the power switch to LINE mode.
- 2.Connect the mini USB end to your speaker.
- 3. Connect the 3.5mm jack to your audio device. 4.Enjoy!



Bluetooth:

- You can also enjoy your music without the limitations of a wire! 1 Slide the power switch to Bluetooth mode.
- 2.Use your device to discover your Bluetooth speaker.
- 3.If prompted to input a code, enter "0000".
- 4. Once connected, you can use your speaker to play music, or you can use it as a hands free device.





Multifunction Button

Hands Free

To answer a call, PRESS the multifunction button. To end a call, PRESS the multifunction button again.


Volume Up/Volume Down

For volume up, rotate and hold the multifunction button to the right. For volume down, rotate and hold the multifunction button to the left.

Skip Forward/Backward

To go to the next song, FLICK the multifunction button to the right. To go to the previous song, FLICK the multifunction button to the left.

How to open/close the speaker resonator



To Open: Step 1. Hold the speaker firmly by its base and top cap.



Step 2. Turn top cap counter clockwise.



The speaker will spring open to extend the resonator to full length. You will experience better sound quality in the open position.



To Close: Hold the speaker firmly by its base and press the top cap down towards the base.



Turn top cap clockwise.
